November 13, 2020 update

We have completed another round of asymptomatic testing of staff and unfortunately, we were advised that another two staff members had tested positive for COVID-19. Both staff members had been working on the second floor and after consultation with AHS, we tested all second floor residents again yesterday and are now awaiting results. Regrettably, this will mean that the date we will now come off the outbreak list will have to be reset which means our re-opening for visits is yet again delayed. Our next meeting with AHS is Tuesday at which point we will have further information in terms of how we might be able to resume some family visitation.

So far we have been fortunate that the COVID outbreaks at ECCC have been contained and we want to acknowledge families and staff for being diligent with the COVID guidance. We are watching very closely the spread that is occurring in the wider community and doing our best to be as prepared as possible for outbreaks.

到目前為止，我們很幸運已經控制了本中心的新冠肺炎大暴發，並且我們要感謝家人和員工積極地遵守新冠肺炎的指引。並密切關注著整個社區正在發生的擴散，亦儘最大努力為有可能爆發做好準備。
