You undoubtedly have seen media stories about long term care and supportive living homes, including a few that focused on Edmonton Chinatown Care Centre. Regrettably there are many seniors homes in Edmonton with outbreaks with some having infection levels similar to what is being experienced at ECCC. As was reported, we did make a decision on the weekend to ask essential care givers to come into the site to help feed which has been very helpful. Thank you.

As of today, we have a total of 48 residents with active COVID-19; 8 are on the first floor; 25 on the second; and 15 on the third. Currently, there are 46 staff who have active COVID-19 and 11 who have recovered.

Sadly, today we report four more four residents have passed away due to COVID-19. As of today, a total of 16 residents have now passed away due to COVID-19. Our condolences to all who have lost a loved one and everyone who has been affected by this.

Our staffing levels continue to improve both with the assistance of our agency partners and the gradual return of ECCC staff who have now recovered. We have also received incredible support from Alberta Health Services who are also assisting so many other sites that are experiencing outbreaks of COVID-19.

We appreciate the words of support we have received and we will do our best to share these with staff. These are tough days for residents and families and for the staff who are doing the best they can.
