As we head into the weekend, we continue to benefit from the number of our staff and agency staff who are working hard to help us through the current challenges. We want to acknowledge our staff who have been able to stay healthy and continue to come to work and to express our relief for those of who have recovered and are now making their way back to ECCC. We are also very thankful for our agency partners who have been able to provide many temporary staff which has made a significant difference.

As of today we have a total of 48 residents with active COVID-19; 9 are on the first floor; 24 on the second; and 16 on the third.

Currently, there are 32 staff who have active COVID-19 and 26 who are considered recovered. We are in regular contact with all staff who have been infected with COVID to support them in their recovery and to prepare for their return.

Since we last reported, we have had three residents pass away and we have now lost a total of 23 residents to COVID-19: one from the first floor; 14 from second; and 8 from third. Our thoughts go out to the family and friends who mourn this loss.
