

## **Indoor Visitation process at Edmonton Chinatown Care Centre**

Edmonton Chinatown Town Care Centre is updating the indoor visitation process effective July 30th, 2021, in compliance with the new CMOH orders 36 and 37-2021.

- Visitation Hours will be from 8:30 am to 8:00 pm
- Visitors will wash their hands and don a new face mask.
- All visitors will complete the appropriate screening tool. A temperature check is not required as part of screening.
- All visitors will be asked to sign in and out.
- Visitors will don a "Visitor" name tag.
- Visitors must wear their masks at all times in shared spaces and common areas.
- Visitors will be provided with a baggie with Oxiver cleaning cloths, visitors are to clean all areas they may have touched while in the room before leaving.
- Up to four visitors can visit together in the resident's room.
- Visitors may dine with the resident in their rooms. At this time, visitors cannot eat in the dining room.
- There is no time limit on visiting.
- Families may take residents for an outing. A risk assessment is no longer required upon return. Please arrange outings with the nurse of your loved one's floor.
- If residents/families would like a larger group indoor visit for a special occasion, contact the Clinical Lead.
