Sadly, today Sunday November 29, 2020 we advise that three residents have passed since our last update. As of today, a total of 11 residents have passed away due to COVID-19. Our sympathies to the all the families and friends our all the residents who have passed away and to the staff who provided their care.

As of today, we have a total of 34 residents with active COVID-19. Of these, 8 residents are on the third floor, 22 are on the second floor, and 4 are on the main floor.

Currently, there are 30 staff who have active COVID-19. We have had a few staff who were previously infected now come back to work and are hoping for a few more during the week. Our staffing agency partners continue to work very hard to direct staff to us which we truly appreciate. Once again, we wish to acknowledge the support we are receiving from Alberta Health Services as we continue to work through these very challenging circumstances.
